Subject Pronouns	Object Pronouns	Possessive Adjectives
I	me	my
you	you	your
he	him	his
she	her	her
it	it	its
we	us	our
they	them	their

Examples:

Hello. **I** am Michael. **I** am a teacher.

This is Mary, **my** daughter. **She** is a student. This is **her** husband, Peter. **He** is an engineer.

She likes **him**, and **he** likes **her**. **I** like **them** and **they** like **me**.

This is **our** house. **We** like **it**. **It** is **our** home. **We** have a dog, **its** name is Poppet.
