Examples of Possessive Adjectives:

1. I like **my** dog.
2. I like **your** house.
3. He likes **his** car.
4. She likes **her** dolls.
5. We like **our** garden.
6. They like **their** house.

Examples of Possessive Pronouns:

1. Do you like this car? It's **mine**. (= It's my car)
2. I like this car. Is it **yours**?
3. Peter is driving a big car. Is it **his**?
4. Susan is driving a pink car. Is it **hers**?
5. We live in this house, but it's not **ours**.
6. They live in this house, but it's not **theirs**.
