

Many English Prepositions Together

4 prepositions together: **Come on in out of the cold!**

9 prepositions together:

“Mummy – what did you bring that book, that I don’t like to be read **to, out of, from about “Down Under” up for?**”

(“Mãe – por que você trouxe aquele livro, do qual eu não queria que fosse lido, sobre Austrália, para cima?”)

Analysis:

to be read to

to be told a story

out of

source

Down Under

Australia

what for ?

why ?

bring up

bring upstairs

A better way:

“Mummy – why did you bring that book, about Australia, upstairs, which I don’t like to hear?”
