

## A List of English Prepositions (not complete!)

In English, there are around 100 prepositions. Here are 46 of them, with examples:

19. I only travel **during** the summer.
20. I passed all my school tests **except** mathematics.
21. **Following** many days of rain, we had a sunny day.
22. I bought flowers **for** my wife.
23. Bob received a new watch **from** his father.
24. I speak many languages, **including** French and German.
25. The cat is **in** the box.
26. The cat jumped **into** the box.
27. My baby sleeps **like** an angel.
28. I live **near** the park.

41. I always stay at work **until** 6pm.
42. He went **up** the stairs to go to bed.

44. David went to France **with** his mother.  
I agree **with** you.
45. I will arrive **within** an hour.  
I believe that programming is **within** your capabilities.
46. I went to the city centre **without** my umbrella.
