

## English Grammar: Pronouns

Subject Pronouns (before the verb)	Object Pronouns (after the verb)
I	me
you	you
he	him
she	her
it	it
you	you
we	us
they	them

### Examples:

- I know **you** and **you** know **me**.
- I know **him** and **he** knows **me**.
- I know **her** and **she** knows **me**.
- I know **them** and **they** know **me**.
- **We** know **you** and **you** know **us**.
- A: I am looking for my laptop. B: I think that **it** is on the sofa. (*thing*)
- A: Where is the cat? B: **It** is in the garden. (*animal*)
- A: Do **you** know Paris? B: Yes! I know **it** well. (*place*)
- Fantastic! **It** is sunny today. (*weather*)

9. \_\_\_\_\_ can go home now. \_\_\_\_\_ will see \_\_\_\_\_ tomorrow. (*teacher to her students*)
10. \_\_\_\_\_ have a dog. \_\_\_\_\_ is so cute. \_\_\_\_\_ love \_\_\_\_\_ so much! (*I and my dog*)
