

## **Landing Card** (*Duration: 01:44*)

This is your I94 arrival and departure form. Please complete it in ink and in block capitals. Section One. Write your family name. Don't forget the block capitals. Section Two is for your first, or given, name. In Section Three, write your birth date. First the day, then the month and finally the year. Section Four is for your country of citizenship. Section Five is sex – male or female. In Section Six, put your passport number. Then in Seven, your airline and flight number. This is on your boarding pass. For example, British Airways flight 177, write BA177. For American Airlines flight 210, write AA210. In Eight, write the country where you are living now. And in Section Nine, the city where you boarded this flight. For Section Ten, look at the visa in your passport. Write the city where the visa was issued. And in Section Eleven, the date of your visa. Again, write day, then month, then year. Section Twelve is your first address in the United States. Put the number and street here. In Section Thirteen, write the city and the state. Put your I94 arrival record in your passport and hand it to Immigration Control in the United States. Thank you for listening.
