

English Sport – The Rules of Cricket

- You have two sides, one out (in the field) and one in (not in the field).
- Each man that's on the side that's “in”, goes out, and when he's “out”, he comes in and the next man goes in until he's out.
- When they are all out, the side that's “out” comes in, and the side that's been in goes out and tries to get those coming in, out.
- Sometimes some players are still in but not out.
- When a man goes out to go in, the men who are out try to get him out, and when he is out he goes in and the next man in goes out and goes in.
- There are two men called umpires who stay out all the time and they decide when the men who are in are out.
- When both sides have been in and all the men have been out, and both sides have been out twice after all the men have been in, including those who are not out, that is the end of the game!
