

# Family Conversations

## 1) Talking About Family

Use a photo of the family – who is in the picture?  
Draw a family tree – talk about who is who.

## 2) Daily Life

Ask and talk about daily activities.  
Practice verbs: wake up, eat, watch TV, walk, sleep.

## 3) Toys and Hobbies

Talk about what the children like and don't like to do/play.

## 4) Pets and Animals

Talk about animals which make good pets.  
Talk about pets in the family.

## 5) Food and Meals

Talk about favorite foods and mealtimes.  
I like / I don't like / Do you like...?  
Use pictures to talk about foods - Brazil/UK  
Role-play: breakfast, coffee shop, restaurant.

## 6) Weather and Seasons

Talk about the weather and express likes/dislikes.  
Talk about recent weather/today's weather (What's the weather today?)  
Vocab: sunny, rainy, windy, cold, hot, etc.

## 7) Birthdays and Celebrations

Ask about ages (How old are you? / How old is \_\_\_\_\_ ?)  
Practise the birthday song.  
Talk about Christmas, Easter, etc.

## 8) Home and Neighborhood

Describe where you live, where your family lives (city, area, country)  
Describe your house (vocab: door, window, garden, kitchen, etc.)  
Talk about contents of your house  
Describe what is close to your home (supermarket, chemist, etc.)

## **9) Video Calls**

Use common phrases/vocab for video calling.

(Can you see me? / Can you hear me? / Wait a moment! / etc.)

Vocab to express emotions (I love you, I miss you, etc.)

Vocab: happy, sad, tired, fine, good, etc.

How are you? / I'm fine, thank you. / etc.

## **10) Travel and Distance**

Talk about travelling to England & Brazil

Use a world map to show England & Brazil.

Vocab: far / near / airplane / visit, etc.

Phrases: go by plane / check in / baggage / etc.

## **11) School**

Talk about school subjects, likes/dislikes

Talk about tests, sporting activities, extra-curricular activities

Talk about going to school (time, distance, route, etc.)
