English vowels have different pronunciations, depending on the words.

1) The letter 'a'

- bag, can, fat, man, chat, fantastic
- bake, late, safe, made, table, inflate
- any, many

2) The letter 'e'

- men, leg, pen, letter, better, tetanus
- metre, lever, Peter, fever, theatre, appreciate

3) The letter 'i'

- win, bit, list, little, application, nativity
- fine, time, smile, sign, final, library

4) The letter 'o'

- hot, fog, top, coffee, bottle, chronological
- go, hope, note, trophy, Pope, broken

5) The letter 'u'

- run, but, butter, up, lucky, umbrella
- cute, university, uniform, flute, unicorn, useful
