## La Casa de Papel

This is a Spanish crime drama series created by Alex Pina. The series received several awards including the International Emmy Award for Best Drama Series at the 46th International Emmy Awards, as well as critical acclaim for its sophisticated plot, interpersonal dramas, direction and innovation. The Italian anti-fascist song "Bella Ciao", which plays multiple times throughout the series, became a summer hit across Europe in 2018. In that year, the series was one of the most-



watched series on Netflix, particularly in Mediterranean Europe and Latin America.



The series follows two heists led by “the Professor” (Alvaro Morte), one on the Royal Mint of Spain, and the other on the Bank of Spain. Each heist is told from the perspective of one of the robbers called “Tokyo”. The Professor recruits a group of eight people, who are given city names as their aliases for anonymity. They first carry out an ambitious plan to enter the Royal Mint of Spain, and escape with €984 million. After taking 67 people hostage, the team plans to remain inside the Mint for 11 days in order to print the money, during which time they must deal with elite police forces. In the events following the heist, the group members are forced out of hiding and they prepare for a second heist, with some additional members, this time aiming to escape with gold from the Bank of Spain, as they again deal with hostages and police forces.
