

Vocabulary – Bread (in the UK)

The word “bread” in English is not countable, so we can’t say “breads”. So, how do we say “6 pães” in English? Well, we use adjectives to describe the type of bread, and other countable nouns to name the bread. The nouns “roll”, “loaf”, “baguette” and “stick” are all countable.
