












* Origin of the word “wake”

In the 16th century, lead cups were used to drink ale or whiskey. The combination of lead and alcohol would sometimes knock you out for a day or two. Someone walking along the road would assume that they were dead and prepare them for burial. However, they were put on the kitchen table for two days and the family would wait to see if the person would wake.



(No século 16, os copos de chumbo eram usados para beber cerveja ou uísque. A combinação de chumbo e álcool às vezes deixava uma pessoa inconsciente por um ou dois dias. Alguém caminhando pela estrada presumiria que a pessoa estava morto e a prepararia para o enterro. Porém, ela era colocada na mesa da cozinha por dois dias e a família esperava para ver se a pessoa acordava.)
