**Materials:** leather, cotton, polyester, silk, suede, satin, wool, nylon, linen, denim

**Patterns:** plain, polka-dot, striped, check/plaid/tartan, flowered

**Note:** We usually use the following order: *color – pattern – material – object*

**Examples:**

<i>a blue tie</i>	<i>black shoes</i>
<i>a blue silk tie</i>	<i>black leather shoes</i>
<i>a blue striped tie</i>	<i>black striped pants</i>
<i>a blue striped silk tie</i>	<i>black striped cotton pants</i>

More examples:

What is he wearing?

He is wearing a red plain cotton polo shirt.

He is wearing black cotton pants and brown leather shoes.

He is wearing a check wool sweater, a white cotton shirt and a green silk tie.

He is wearing a blue striped polyester suit, a red tie and black leather shoes.

What is she wearing?

She is wearing an orange and white check cotton skirt and a beige satin blouse.

She is wearing a black plain dress and high-heels.

She is wearing a red nylon skirt, a pink polka-dot cotton blouse and white socks.
