

English Vocabulary – Fair

1) Fair: Justice / Ethics (adjective)

Synonyms: equitable, impartial, just

Examples:

- a fair decision
- a fair judge (not biased)
- a fair compromise
- a fair chance
- fair words

2) Fair: Quality / Degree (adjective)

Meaning: good, but not excellent

Examples:

- The results were fair
- Her French is fair

3) Fair: Physical Appearance (adjective)

Meaning: light-colored

Examples:

- fair skin
- fair hair

4) Fair: Weather / Conditions (adjective)

Meaning: clear, pleasant, favorable

Examples:

- We expect fair weather today
- The skies will be fair tomorrow

5) Fair: Events (noun)

Meaning: organized public event or exhibition

- Agricultural or trade events: a county fair
- Entertainment-based: a funfair
- Technological event: a computer fair

6) Fair: Sports (adjective/adverb)

Meaning: within the rules

Examples:

- a fair ball
- play fair

7) Fair: Expressions

- fair enough → acceptable
- fair and square → honestly and directly
- the fair sex → women
- fair game → legitimate target for criticism or attack
