1) correct:

- to be right
- to get (something) right

- on the right / left
- right-hand side / left-hand side
- to be right-handed / left-handed

- right wing / left wing
- a right winger / a left winger
- to be far right / to be far left

4) human/legal right(s):

- human rights
- legal rights
- voting rights
- right of way
- to be within your rights
- to have the right to do something
- to exercise the right to do something
- to win the right to do something
- an acquired right

5) trigonometry:

- right angle (90° or $\pi/2$ radians)

6) immediately:

- right away / right now
- I'll be right back (BRB)
- I'll be right there ("Estou chegando")
- right before
- right after

7) emphasis:

- right here
- right there
- right in the middle

8) directly

- right to the subject
- right to the point

9) adverb (rightly):

- He rightly refused to take it.
- Rightly or wrongly,

10) confirmation:

- Right!
- Alright!
- All right!
- You are right!

Opposite of "right":

not right
wrong
incorrect
mistaken
left

Opposite of "rightly":

not rightly
wrongly
incorrectly
mistakenly
