















# English Vocabulary: The Weather













## 1. Vocabulary (nouns)

## 2. Describing the weather (adjectives/verbs)

Q: What's the weather like today?

A: It's \_\_\_\_\_ .

	It's sunny.		It's rainy. It's raining. It's wet.
	It's windy.		It's snowy. It's snowing.
	It's cloudy.		It's stormy.
	It's warm. It's hot. It's very hot. It's boiling.		It's cool. It's cold. It's very cold. It's freezing.
	It's humid.		It's dry.
	It's foggy.		It's drizzly. It's drizzling.

## Present/Past/Future

Today: Q: What **is** the weather like today?

A: It **is** \_\_\_\_\_ .

Yesterday: Q: What **was** the weather like yesterday?

A: It **was** \_\_\_\_\_ .

Tomorrow: Q: What **will** the weather **be** like tomorrow?

A: (I think) It **will be** \_\_\_\_\_ .

## 3. Temperature

Q: What's the temperature today? A: It's \_\_\_\_\_ .

Examples: 30°C = It's 30 degrees Centigrade.

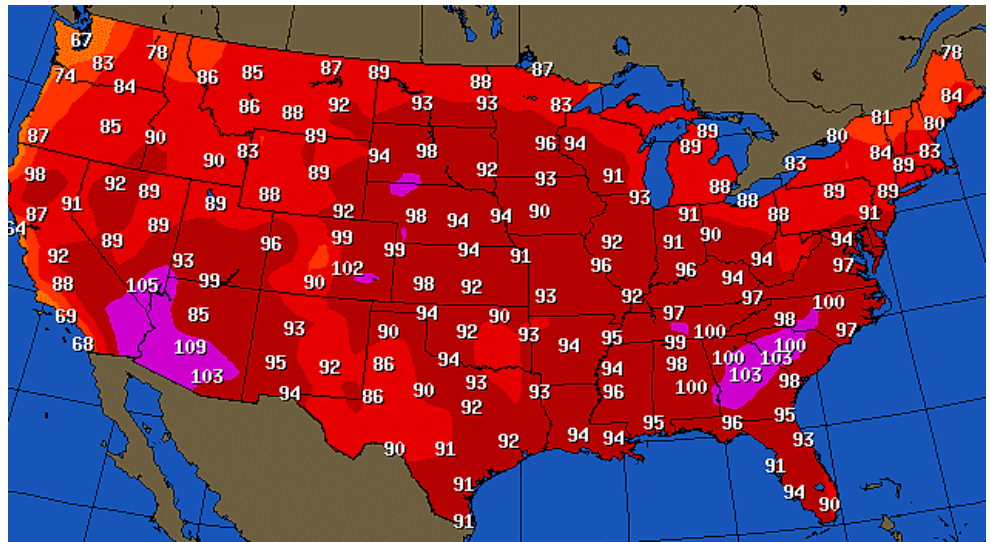
58°F = It's 58 degrees Fahrenheit.

-10°C = It's minus 10 degrees Centigrade. / It's 10 degrees below zero.

0°F = It's zero degrees Fahrenheit.

°C = degrees Centigrade/Celsius, °F = degrees Fahrenheit (only in the USA!)

### Temperature adjectives (°C):

> 40°	boiling
35-40°	very hot
30-35°	hot
20-30°	warm
15-20°	fresh / cool / chilly
10-15°	cold
0-10°	very cold
< 0°	freezing

### How do we say “Sensação térmica” in English?

We say “wind chill” or “it feels like”:

- The actual temperature today is 10 degrees, but **the wind chill** is 5 degrees.
- The actual temperature today is 10 degrees, but **it feels like** it's 5 degrees.


